Primary Responsibilities:

Attend morning huddles and contribute to daily team objectives. Consistently provide professional, friendly, and engaging service to all guests. Ensure Aatmos and departmental standards are followed at all times. Respond promptly to guests' special requests and service needs. Maintain inventory of necessary supplies and ensure storage areas are organized. Replace bed linens, clean guest rooms, and maintain hotel cleanliness to the highest standards. Report any maintenance issues, damaged property, or safety concerns immediately. Assist with the sorting, washing, drying, and folding of hotel linens as needed. Be able to lift up to 50 pounds. Maintain property grounds and public spaces in excellent condition. Stay accessible to front desk, housekeeping, and the Operations Manager to support overall hotel operations. Follow all safety and sanitation policies to ensure a secure environment for guests and staff. Assist other departments when necessary to provide optimum service to guests. Must be able to stand, walk up and down stairs, and bend and kneel repeatedly. Perform additional duties as needed to support hotel operations.

HOUSING & TRANSPORTATION

Host Employer assists with housing, and it will be a Dormitory.

- **Housing** is required for the job placement for the duration of your program.
- **Participants** will be required to sign a housing agreement. By signing the program information guide and/or housing agreement, participants are agreeing to stay at housing that has been pre-arranged for the entire length of the agreement.
- **You** will be required to make initial housing payments prior to and/or upon arrival, which could include security deposit & setup fee. After that time, housing will be paid weekly by cash or credit card to housing manager.
- **Any** damage to the property will result in participants paying the cost as determined by the housing management.
- **Detailed** housing arrangement will be disclosed by GEC prior to arrivals.
- **Housing** cost is \$140 per week (based on 4 occupants per room) and paid weekly to housing manager by cash or credit card.
- **Your** Host Employer will assign rooming lists based on arrival/departure dates and specific roommates may not be guaranteed.
- **When** offered the placement, by signing the Work Agreement and Program Information Guide, exchange visitors assume responsibility to read the housing rules and abide by all terms and conditions.
- **Various** Transportation options available and might include Public Transportation, Taxi/Shuttle Service, & Ride Share (Uber/Lyft).

When you have been selected, please carefully review your final placement details in your Program Information Guide. It is your responsibility to read and understand your placement details BEFORE signing your work agreement and Program Information Guide acknowledgment form that indicates the acceptance of your placement details.

While the work component of your program will provide some funds throughout your program, your wages earned in the U.S. may not cover all of your living expenses or the costs associated with expenses to come to the U.S. Use the budget section in your Participant Handbook to ensure you have enough funds.



PIGEON FORGE, TENNESSEE

Pigeon Forge, a mountain town and vacation area in eastern Tennessee, is the home of Dollywood, country singer Dolly Parton's Appalachian-themed Park consisting of rides, an adjoining water park and a museum of her costumes and memorabilia. The city's other attractions include country music revues like the Smoky Mountain Opry, dinner theaters such as Dolly Parton's Dixie Stampede and outlet malls. At Pigeon Forge, a moment can last a lifetime. The magic that encompasses our Smoky Mountain town during winter months will have your family feeling the joy and wonder of the holidays. From bountiful options of belly-warming comfort food restaurants to holiday-clad events, to enchanting shows and attractions, the whole family will find their moment in the mountains. Great Smoky Mountains National Park was established on June 15, 1934. Today the park is the largest protected land area east of the Rocky Mountains and has become the most visited national park in the American Park System. The main entrances are located along US Highway 441. As a matter of fact, there are over 80 hiking trails in our backyard here in the Smoky Mountains! From the three cities of Pigeon Forge, Gatlinburg, and Sevierville to the Great Smoky Mountains.
